Any applications for licence to conduct activities in a public place are governed by the “Tauranga Street Use and Public Places Bylaw”.

Conditions of the Licence:

1. The licence conditions must be produced if requested by an authorised officer.
2. Activities in private areas (ie, malls) will require the permission of the building / land owner as Council has no control over these areas.
3. Licensees must ensure that there is free and safe access provided for pedestrians.
4. Licensees must not block shop doorways during business hours, fire escapes, bus stops and road ways.
5. Licensees must not remain at a location if requested to move by an authorised officer.
6. Licensees must not sell any food or merchandise without permission.
7. Licensees must ensure that they do not create adverse effects whether by noise or any other means.
8. Licensees are not permitted to operate in Red Square (Mid City Mall) unless otherwise permitted by an authorised officer.
9. Annual licences must be renewed prior to the expiry date.

You must comply with all reasonable instructions of an authorised officer. Failure to comply with any of the requirements of this notice may lead to the cancellation of the licence and prosecution.
