How the Formal Submission process works



Draft proposal for consultation

A draft proposal is developed and adopted by Council. To find out what the community thinks, the proposal is opened for public consultation, usually for one month.



Final proposal

Any changes are made, the proposal is finalised and adopted by Council.



When are decisions made?

Elected Members make decisions, based on the submissions and research, during what is called **Deliberations**. These are open meetings, so you can come and listen!



Have your say and make a formal submission

You can make a submission online or in writing. Make sure it reaches Council before the deadline.

On paper

Print out a submission form from our website or pick one up from Council offices or the local library.



Do you want to be heard?

You can choose whether or not you would like to speak in support of your submissions at the relevant Council meeting. This is called a **Hearing**. There is usually a 10 minute timeframe for each speaker.
